

International Choir Festival of Almada From February 23 to 27, 2023



A magnificent bay, the Tagus estuary, spanned by an endless bridge, the Vasco da Gama bridge, sloping streets climbed by the tram, a visit to Lisbon looks like European San Francisco if not the other way around, elders oblige.

During your stay in the capital of Portugal, the most western in Europe, you will take advantage of your vacation to discover a rich heritage that dates back to Roman times and which then crossed centuries and influences, especially Muslims, until today.

From the Tower of Belém, the old port from which Vasco da Gama set out in 1497 to conquer the world to the futuristic Park of Nations, built for the Universal Exhibition of 1998, to the grandiose Trade Square (Praça do comercio), where the historic heart of the city beats, with the Saint-Georges Castle and its magnificent panorama ideal for taking pictures of Lisbon or in its other districts, there are many things to see absolutely.

The Portuguese capital is also suitable for walks through time in the cobbled streets of the old quarters of Alfama and in the Bairro alto, or to laze in summer on the many sandy beaches in the area accessible by public transport such as than Cascais or Estoril, a lukewarm pastel de nata in mouth.

Almada

Located on the south bank of the Tagus River, Almada is arguably the best viewpoint over the city of Lisbon, with among other observation points the castle, the panoramic lift of the Boca do Vento, and mainly the statue of Christ the King erected in 1959.

In the past centuries, Almada was a popular vacation spot for the court, which built there some noble buildings and houses preserved by the city.

Today, Almada is a city that maintains its growth, the pace of which increased with the inauguration of the bridge over the Tagus in 1966, which facilitated access between the two banks of the river. However, Almada does not only live by the capital where a large part of its inhabitants work, it is a city with a life of its own and its popular events like the Theater Festival.

The municipality of Almada also includes the Costa da Caparica, much sought after in summer by the inhabitants of Lisbon and its suburbs, seduced by its vast sandy beaches. The local gastronomy deserves special attention, in particular the tasty bouillabaisses of fresh fish, typical of places such as Cacilhas, Porto Brandão, Ginjal or Costa da Caparica.

<u>São Jorge Castle:</u> Open to the public 7 days a week, the Castelo de S. Jorge offers you to enjoy a historical site, where you can learn a little more about the history of Lisbon at the Permanent Exhibition, explore the remains of the Islamic quarter from the 11th century on the Archaeological Site, admire absolutely incredible panoramas of the city thanks to the Dark Room, stroll through the gardens and the belvedere, take a break at the Café do Castelo, or quite simply, let yourself be charmed by the music, the theater, dance and heritage conversation circles that animate the days of this remarkable Lisbon monument.

Then, take advantage of the many lookouts that this district has to offer, such as **the Santa Luzia lookout point** or the **Miradouro das Portas do Sol.**

Then discover the **Cathedral of Santa Maria Maior** in Lisbon (or **Sé Patriarchal Cathedral of Lisboa - Free entry -**)

Visit to the cloister: € 2.50 / person - Visit to the treasure: € 2.50 / person The **Panteão Nacional** (which is the old church of Santa Engrácia) and the **Monastery of Sao Vicente de Fora**.

Don't hesitate to check out the **Feira da Ladra** (literally "thief's fair"), which is the best-known and most famous flea market in the capital. The market takes place every Tuesday and Saturday, in the Campo de Santa Clara, between the São Vicente monastery and the Praça Doutor Bernardino Antonio Gomes.

The Fado Museum. *Price:* 5 €/pers (full price). Fado is a traditional Portuguese song. It is a lament that questions fate against which we can do nothing. Indeed, it comes from the Latin word "fatum" which means "destiny". It is the musical symbol of Portugal.


