Come and discover Normandy with its varied landscapes, its architectural, cultural, historical and environmental heritage which makes it one of the most visited regions in France, rich in fascinating history, from the Vikings to the D-Day landings in June 1944. The D-Day landing on 6 June 1944 was a decisive turning point in the Second World War. From the Dieppe Raid in 1942, the liberation of France and Europe began on the Normandy beaches.

In 2024, Normandy will commemorate and celebrate the 80th anniversary of D-Day and the Battle of Normandy. The whole of Normandy will be called upon to honour the memory of these events and of the men and women who came from all over the world to liberate us.

The Normandy Festival will be part of the programme for this anniversary.

Thursday June 13, 2024 : Utah Beach

Breakfast Transfer for Utah Beach



Visit to the D-Day Landing Museum: Guided tour 1h30 (Museum, monuments, the beach)

Built on the very spot where American troops landed on 6 June 1944, the museum tells the story of D-Day in ten sequences, from its preparation to its outcome and success. Utah Beach was the first beach to be stormed by the Allies on the morning of 6 June 1944. It was chosen to establish a bridgehead in the Cotentin region in order to capture the town of Cherbourg and its deep water port.

At the end of the day, more than 23,000 American soldiers landed to fight a titanic battle and liberate France.

The Utah Beach Landing Museum preserves the memory of these men. Thanks to a complete chronological tour, plunge into the history of the Landing and discover a collection rich in objects, vehicles, equipment and testimonies.

In the heart of the Normandy landing beaches, the American cemetery of Colleville sur Mer overlooks Omaha Beach. A must-see during your visit to the Normandy beaches, it contains the graves of 9,387 fallen soldiers, the chapel, the memorial and the garden of the missing.

The visitors' centre pays tribute to these soldiers and their courage in carrying out Operation Overlord and enabling the liberation of Europe.

THE BAYEUX TAPESTRY, AN 11TH CENTURY WORK UNIQUE IN THE WORLD

Over a length of almost 70 metres, immerse yourself in the embroidered story of the conquest of England in 1066 by William, Duke of Normandy. The visit to the museum allows you to discover the Bayeux Tapestry in its entirety, to approach it without damaging it and to understand its history and its creation thanks to an audio-guided commentary in 16 languages. A junior commentary is also available in French and English. A permanent exhibition on the first floor enriches the visit.

However, the city is not only about its cathedral: spared by the 1944 bombings, Bayeux boasts an exceptional architectural heritage where the skills of the craftsmen have been expressed with talent. The former capital of the Bajocasses, a people of Gaul, can pride itself on its embroidery, lace and porcelain.

Saturday June 15, 2024 : Mont Saint Michel

LE MONT SAINT MICHEL - FREE TIME

Mont-Saint-Michel is unique in that it is built on a rocky islet, surrounded by a magnificent bay, the scene of the highest tides in continental Europe. The Mont and its bay are classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Between Normandy and Brittany, this grandiose site, located 3.5 hours from Paris, is one of the most visited monuments in France.

It was the maritime environment that determined the choice of the monks in the Middle Ages to settle in this precise location and build what was to become one of the most extraordinary buildings in religious architecture. Aubert, bishop of Avranches, is said to have founded a sanctuary on Mont-Tombe in 708, after three successive apparitions of the archangel Saint Michael. Overlooking the immensity of the bay, the abbey of Mont-Saint-Michel is the highlight of the visit. To get there, there is a maze of stairs and medieval alleys where it is good to stroll. The village, protected by ramparts built between the 12th and 14th centuries, is home to charming half-timbered houses.

Sunday June 16, 2024 : Coutances

30km / 40 min

Dominated by the towers of its cathedral, the City of Art and History of Coutances has a beautiful religious heritage. Built in the 13th century, the Notre-Dame cathedral is a remarkable example of Norman Gothic art.

Discover its nave, its 13th century stained glass windows and its superb lantern tower, a Gothic masterpiece. Not far from the cathedral, the plant garden is a particularly relaxing place to stroll around.





The ancient city of Manche was once the capital of the Unelles, a Celtic people, before being populated by the Romans who modernised it. Ravaged by Viking raids in the medieval period, the city also suffered from the Wars of Religion, notably with the looting of the cathedral by the Huguenots. Capital of Cotentin during the Ancien Régime, it lost this title in 1795 to Saint-Lô. In the 20th century, Coutances suffered deadly bombing during the Second World War. Despite its reconstruction, it has retained a certain charm and many authentic monuments.




