In 2024, the Competition will once again take place in the superb seaside resort of La Seyne sur Mer, in the Toulon area.





ANNEXE 1: Touristic Suggestions: Marseille

Breakfast

65 km / 55 minutes





France's second-largest city, Marseille has kept alive the values of sharing that have shaped its territory for centuries, and is still known as the "Phocaean City" in memory of the ancient Greeks from Asia Minor who founded the city there.

A port city with a strong identity, it has also evolved over time to become a major Mediterranean capital open to the world.



With over 300 days of sunshine a year, summer begins earlier in Marseille than elsewhere. The mistral, which blows 90 days a year, paints the Marseille sky with a unique purity and light that the greatest artists have captured on their canvases.





Tourist activities (suggestions):

Sightseeing train ride to visit the city's main sites: €11 per person

Notre Dame de la Garde (Basilica with 360° view of the city) - Free of charge Mucem Museum (European civilization): additional €20 per person

Vieux Port de Marseille (free) / La Corniche (beautiful road along the sea)



ANNEXE 2: Touristic Suggestions: Cassis

Breakfast

Cassis: immersed in nature, with pine forests, ochre and white rocks, terraced and flat vineyards stretching right down to the Mediterranean, Cassis is protected by two natural monuments: Cap Canaille (Europe's highest sea cliff), which lights up in the mistral wind, and the Calanques, made of white limestone.

"Those who visit Paris without visiting Cassis have seen nothing".

These words alone by Nobel literature prizewinner Frédéric Mistral convey the formidable attraction that Cassis exerts on all those who visit it.

Easy access to the beach, swimming permitted.



This small fishing port, nestled between two natural sites, offers visitors a concentrate of Provence and the Mediterranean.

The magic begins on the narrow road leading to the village, winding through vineyards and pine forests. The charm is revealed as you stroll through the narrow streets and squares lined with colorful fishermen's cottages.

A replica of the Parisian chic of the left bank in the depths of Provence, Aix) is very classy: its green boulevards and public squares are lined with 17th and 18th century mansions, punctuated by gurgling fountains covered with moss. Haughty stone lions guard its largest avenue, the Cours Mirabeau bordered by cafes, where fashionable Aixois pose on polished paved terraces, sipping espresso.



Many cultural activities are possible in Aix: visit of the house and workshop of Paul Cézanne, the Granet Museum, the Vasarély foundation, Vineyards visits & tasting, the Vendôme Pavilion, guided tours of the old town, ...

Facing its **magnificent gulf** saturated with light, nestled between its hills covered with broom, pines and mulberry trees, Bandol is one of the largest and oldest seaside resorts on the coast. The sandy beaches which border the bay of Bandol are numerous. Lido beach to the east, Casino beach to the south, Renécros beach pleasantly nestled at the bottom of a famous cove

But you will not leave Bandol without tasting the calm and the voluptuous beauty of the multiple coves that line the path to the corniche. Also accessible by boat, these natural coves will allow you to combine the pleasure of a sea trip with that of a privileged swim.

Red, rosé or white ... The **famous wines of Bandol** invite you to discover an authentic and unique terroir ... Composed of about fifty estates, the Bandol vineyard was one of the first to receive the AOC appellation. (Designation of Origin Controlled) in 1941.

Easy access to the beach, swimming allowed.








ANNEXE 5: Touristic Suggestions: Nice




