


International Choir Festival of Tuscany From May 22 to 26, 2024 Standard Program - 5 days 4 nights



Tuscany! A magical word that makes you want to escape, or even go into exile... Groves of cypress trees sparingly arranged on the hills. The old farmhouses of Chianti immersed in a tide of holm oaks, with the sound and light of cicadas and the weight of the sun. The feverish Maremma and its Etruscan hinterland full of open-air catacombs. Romanesque chapels and hamlets topped with square dovecotes. Dusty dirt roads lined with dry stone walls and olive trees.

Nourishing and enchanting, Tuscany speaks to the mind as well as the body. But no matter how magnificent the scenery, it still needs artists to give it its true face, to magnify and interpret it.

Tuscany has never been short of artists, especially during the Renaissance, with painters like Piero della Francesca who were able to capture and enhance the essence of the landscape. The painters of the Quattrocento showed off the country, using the veduta: a window opening onto the countryside, giving depth to the painting.

Lucca is one of Tuscany's most beloved artistic cities, an unskippable part of any tour of the region. Nicknamed the town of a hundred churches on account of its incredible number of places of worship, it is unique among city-states for having maintained its independence up until 1847. Historical circumstances demanded that Lucca fortify itself, and so its immense artistic and architectural heritage is ringed by a massive circuit of defensive walls.

Enjoy an unforgettable visit to the capital of the **Italian Renaissance**, where you can explore iconic sites such as the **majestic cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore**, the Uffizi Gallery containing masterpieces by great masters such as Michelangelo and Botticelli, and the famous Ponte Vecchio across the Arno. Immerse yourself in the lively atmosphere of **Piazza della Signoria**, home to Palazzo Vecchio and the **statue of David**. You can also relax in the magnificent **Boboli Gardens**, a haven of peace in the heart of the city...









The historic centre of Florence is an open-air museum, with probably the greatest concentration of artistic masterpieces in the world!

Among the most famous are the **Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore (Duomo),** of course, with its dome and Museo dell'Opera, **Giotto's campanile**, Ghiberti's baptistery and gates, the **Palazzo Vecchio** and the **Piazza della Signoria**, which sums up the entire history of Florence. Not forgetting the Ponte Vecchio, the emblem of Florence, which spans the Arno... You won't believe your eyes!

The famous **Leaning Tower of Pisa**, in central Italy, is a symbol of the country. Since 2001, it has been possible to take a quick tour of the tower and climb it via a spiral staircase.

The Piazza dei Miracoli is Pisa's most important cultural and historical centre. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1987, it is home not only to the famous Leaning Tower, but also to the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Assumption and the Baptistery.





Most people know the campanile or free-standing bell tower of Pisa as the "Leaning Tower of Pisa". The Torre Pendente was built on marshy ground from 1173, which is why the tower was already beginning to sag when the third floor was erected. Nevertheless, construction continued and by 1350 it was complete. Several interventions have already been carried out to limit the tower's inclination. As a result, the building is once again safe and accessible to the public. The tower, which is around 56 metres high, was originally part of the Duomo, which is also located in the Piazza dei Miracoli.
