

International Choir Festival & Competition in Vasto

From November 10 to 12, 2023





Vasto is located on the Adriatic Sea, about 80 km south of Pescara. It is a fascinating town with a rich heritage, consisting of an upper part with older buildings and a seaside part with its seaside resort, Marina di Vasto.

Vasto has a long history, which can be discovered by walking through the city streets. It was founded by the Greeks, but its most important remains date back to Roman times: thermal baths, mosaics, cisterns and even the remains of an amphitheatre.

In cooperation with the Histonium Polyphonic choir «B. Lupacchino dal Vasto» choir of Vasto, CHORAL EVENTS is organising an International Choir Competition in November 2023.

Participating choirs will be able to perform concerts in the municipalities of the Vasto area, if they so wish.

A large gala concert with award ceremony in VASTO will conclude this beautiful event. At the end of the competition, the choirs will be offered a few days of tourism in Rome.

Termoli is a popular tourist resort on the Adriatic coast which has long sandy beaches, historic fortifications and some incredible trabocchi.

Vasto is located in the Abruzzi region on the Adriatic Sea. Its origins date back to the 9th century BC. Diomedes, king of Etolia, gave it the name Iston (from Mount Iston) which became Histonium at the end of the 1st century BC.

The historic centre of Vasto has preserved many remains from the Roman period, such as: the Porta Nuova, the best preserved of the city walls; the opus reticulatum walls, visible inside the Chiesa della Trinità.

Visit to the Benedictine Abbey of San Giovanni in Venere in Fossacesia, that from the promontory overlooking the Trabocchi coast with all its austere beauty. With the beautiful portal of the Moon, the crypt with frescoes and the pleasant cloister, it is an extraordinary example of artistic syncretism between Romanesque and Gothic art.

Bus trip on the tourist road 16 Adriatica, along the so-called Costa dei Trabocchi, I 30 km more suggestive of Abruzzo. To determine the uniqueness are overflowing, ancient wooden structures used for fishing, suspended in a dream between the blue sky and the blue sea.

The Colosseum : The symbol is universally known in Rome! Built between 72 and 82 A.D., he could hold up to 50,000 people attend fighting Gladiators and ferocious beasts. Subsequently, it will be widely imitated (Arles, Nîmes...). This symbol of ancient Rome takes the name of Colosseum that in the middle ages, well after the emperor Hadrian did move the colossal statue of Nero, 35 m high.

Roman Forum: it takes a little imagination to represent you from the remnants of today what could be this vast Roman forum. It consisted of temples dedicated to the deified emperors, basilicas and shops. Public gathering place, debates and trade, the forum at the time of the Republic was the people before the rostrum (called the mouthparts) and the Senate in the building called Curia.

Mount Palatine in Rome is located close to the Roman Forum and the Colosseum. The Palatine Hill is one of the seven hills of Rome where you can discover, in the heart of a beautiful garden, the ruins of the ancient Palace of the Roman emperors. The ruins are not particularly impressive and often difficult to understand, but the framework of greenery is enchanting and magnificent city views.

Do not miss the House of Livia and Augustus reopened in 2007 and whose frescoes were restored

The Basilica Saint Pierre of Rome, is located in the Vatican, in the West of the city. It is the main church of Catholicism, his spiritual and also the largest centre. Note that it is not the Cathedral of Rome since this is St. John Lateran that provides this function. Its architecture, its beauty and richness make it one of the essential steps of a stay in Rome. Note that due to the enhanced security controls, access can take time, with sometimes a long queue in the Sun. Access to the Basilica Saint Pierre is free, to the paying dome. **Free entrance.**

On the right bank of the Tiber and close to the Vatican, **the Château Saint Ange** owes its name to the St. Michel Archangel who appeared to Pope Gregory I during a procession.

The Archangel have holstered his sword, thus signifying the end of the plague then rampant in the city. Since then, the statue at its Summit commemorates the event. This huge tumulus was built in 135 by the emperor Hadrian to become his mausoleum. It was then topped with a statue of the Emperor and a Quadriga. It will serve as a mausoleum to the emperors until Septimius Severus in 211. It will eventually have an important military role. Château Saint Ange became a bastion of the one wall. In the Middle-Ages it becomes the fortress protecting the Vatican in addition to





Trevi Fountain: Built at the request of Pope Benedict XIV, it is the work of Nicolas Salvi who completes it in 1762. The fountain came to replace the mouth of the Roman aqueduct which still brings water from a source, the Acqua Virgine. A young girl named Trevi, would have revealed the location of the source to Roman soldiers to save her virginity, story told on the bas-reliefs of the fountain. This monumental fountain, tucked away in a Palace, takes the form of a temple or a triumphal arch.
